Headteacher Update

Staff versus Pupils termly football match

– as always, a competition that all pupils want to be involved in and the competitive nature of our pupils did not waiver throughout the whole 90 minutes. The match was played on a full-sized pitch, with an undulating surface that would have challenged a professional team. The teams were split into Key Stages, one from KS4 and one from KS3 (supported by 5 staff members).



The keys to the game were positive teamwork and effective communication, these were demonstrated in buckets by both sides and it was end to end stuff. Goals scored in minutes 6 (KS3), 7 (KS4), 13 (KS3), 16 (KS4), 26 (KS3), 29 (KS4), 48 (KS3), 61 (KS4), 77 (KS3), 84 (KS3) – final score KS3 6 vs KS4 4. **A huge congratulations to both teams who worked hard, worked as a team and never gave up.**



English update

In English lessons, our reading strategy is moving at pace and all children have access to a range of books in school. If your child would like to borrow books from school, they simply need to ask their Tutor. In KS4, pupils have been reading 'Manga' books and they have formed a Manga Club which reads at break and lunch times, well done KS4.



Maths update

In Maths, the whole school have been making excellent progress with measurements; converting from metric to imperial and vice versa, distance, weight, area and volume as well as learning about shapes, 2D and 3D.
